CORRIGENDUM NO- 1

Section No-6.2 – Collection of RFQ- may be read as:

Bidders can collect the RFQ in person from OPGC office at 7th Floor, Fortune Tower, Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India by paying Rs 50,000/- (Rupees fifty thousand only) or USD 1,000/- (US Dollar one thousand only) in form of Demand Draft or Pay Order issued from an scheduled bank in favor of “Odisha Power Generation Corporation Limited” payable at Bhubaneswar, Odisha, India. The Bidders can also collect the RFQ by remittance of the above-mentioned amount to the specified bank account of “Odisha Power Generation Corporation Limited”. Bidders may also download the RFQ from OPGC website and shall submit the above application money in the form of demand draft or Pay Order along with the QP submission. The last date for collecting/downloading the RFQ is as per the schedule mentioned in Section **4.2** above.

Section No-6.4 – Bidders’ Due Diligence complete -may be read as:

QP submission shall be conclusive evidence that the Bidder has familiarized itself with all conditions. Further, it shall be deemed that by QP submission, the Bidder has:

- (a) made a complete and careful examination of the RFQ; and,
- (b) accepted the risk of inadequacy, error or mistake in the information provided in the RFQ or furnished by or on behalf of OPGC related to any of the matters referred in this Section **6.4**; and,
- (c) received all relevant information requested from OPGC; and,
- (d) agreed to be bound by the undertakings provided by it under and in terms hereof.

OPGC shall not be liable for any omission, mistake or error with respect to any of the above or on account of any matter or thing arising out of or concerning or relating to the RFQ or the bidding process, including any error or mistake therein or in any information or data given by OPGC.

All other sections of this RFQ remain unaltered.
