TERMS OF REFERENCE OF COST AUDIT FOR OPGC.

Cost audit shall be conducted in 2(two) phases (Phase –I covering the period from April to September and Phase –II covering the period from October to March).

1.0.AUDIT TEAM

The selected firm would have to deploy sufficient number of Cost Accountants, semi-qualified persons and article assistants / audit staff for reasonable duration of time for conducting and completion of each Audit report. The Head of Finance of the unit will coordinate with the audit Team for smooth functioning of the audit. It should be ensured that the audit team is headed at all times by Cost Accountant with a team member having more than 3 years of Cost Audit experience or more than 10 years of employment experience in state or central power sector with prior experience of cost auditing on the SAP-ERP platform. The senior partner of the firm will be required to attend half-yearly Audit Committee meetings (generally held at Bhubaneswar) to brief the significant matters covered under cost audit reports issued.

2.0.AUDIT REPORT

Cost audit firm so appointed shall commence cost audit and submit necessary reports as per the schedule communicated by OPGC, along with reservation or qualification or observation or suggestion, if any in form CRA-3 and annexures as per notification or any other instruction issued by Central Government from time to time or any other section of the Companies Act 2013.

After completion of Cost Audit, a presentation on the Cost comparison along with suggestions are to be given by the Auditor at OPGC Corporate Office/ITPS.

3.0.AUDIT FEE, MINIMUM MANDAYS PER PHASE OF AUDIT AND TRAVELLING EXPENSES

Audit Fee for the year is INR 1,80,000/- plus GST. In addition, one time to & fro journey fare by Air or Rail for each Phase of audit shall be paid as detailed below:

Journey should be performed by the shortest route in the entitled class given below:

- One Partner: Economy class by Air / AC 1st Class by Rail
- Others: AC 2 Tier by Rail

Boarding, Lodging and Local Transportation will be provided by the Company free of cost at the ITPS site. GST, as applicable, will be paid as per the relevant Laws. Accommodation at Guest House, OPGC ITPS, Banharpali shall be provided with free of cost during the Engagement Period.

Apart from the Audit Fee stated above, Out of Pocket expenses shall be limited to INR 60,000/- half yearly which shall be paid with approval of OIC against documentary evidence.

4.0.PAYMENT OF AUDIT FEES

The Fee stated at section 3.0 & above shall be payable after completion of Audit. The Invoice shall be submitted to DDO, OPGC Corporate Office after completion of the service. The fee shall be exclusive of applicable GST.

5.0. GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE EOI AND EVALUATION OF THE PROPOSAL

- a. Top 3 (three) firms on the basis of marks obtained out of 70 (Seventy) marks out of 100 marks as specified in the Evaluation Criteria (Annexure-C) shall be shortlisted and would be called for a presentation before OPGC Management at OPGC Corporate Office, Bhubaneswar;
- b. Balance 30 Marks would be evaluated based on the outcome of the presentation. Marks obtained in the presentation stage (out of 30 marks) would be added to the marks obtained in the above stage (out of 70 marks) as stated above in Sl. no. 5 (a), to finalize the total marks;
- c. Firm with the maximum mark at stage “b” (combination of 70 marks- Evaluation Criteria & 30 marks – Presentation) above would be appointed as the Cost Auditor for the FY 26-27 and may be renewed for FY 27-28 based on the performance during FY 26-27;
- d. OPGC reserves its right to accept or reject any application(s) without assigning any reasons thereof. The decision of the Company in this regard shall be final and binding upon the firms participating in the process;
- e. The Cost Auditor will ensure that the information obtained in respect of the working/operation of the unit is maintained in strict confidence and secrecy at all times, including after the completion of the assignment. All such information shall remain exclusive property of OPGC at all the times. A certificate towards maintaining confidentiality is to be provided by the Audit firm at the time of acceptance of Audit assignment;
- f. Assignment of work in subsequent year i.e. for FY 27-28 may be made only subject to satisfactory performance;
- g. **In case the Cost Audit Firms, which have already acted as Cost Auditors in OPGC during last two (2) financial years i.e. FY 24-25 and FY 25-26 shall not be considered for this EOI.** It shall be the responsibility of such firms not to participate in the process or in canvassing in any form or to motivate the employee of the organization in wrong doing.
- h. The Cost Audit Firm will be debarred from getting, in future, any assignments in OPGC and its subsidiaries / JVs in the following cases:
 - i. If the Firm obtains the appointment on the basis of misrepresentation of information/ misstatement of facts at the time of submission of application/documents along with EOI.
 - ii. The Cost Audit Firm is found to have sub-contracted the work.
 - iii. If the Firm does not take-up audit in terms of the appointment letter.
 - iv. If the Firm does not submit the Audit Report, complete in all respects in terms of the appointment.
- i. The venue of the Arbitration, if any shall be Bhubaneswar & Bhubaneswar courts will have exclusive Jurisdiction.
