Revised Qualifying Criteria

- 1) Party must have executed Field Operation services Contract for the operation of BTG, BOP and WTP for 300 MW unit size or above and plant station capacity of 1000 MW or above in Govt. / Public sector or in Private IPPs / CPPs .

And

Party must have executed Ash Handling Plant operation service contract for 135 MW unit size or above and station capacity of 500 MW or above in Govt. / Public sector or in Private IPPs / CPPs.

- 2) Must have successfully provided similar services** during last Three years ending the last day of the month previous to the one in which tenders are invited.

- a) At least single contract of value not less than Rs. 29.00 Crore for Similar service.

Or

- b) At least of two contracts of value not less than Rs. 22.00 Crore each for similar service.

Or

- c) At least of three contracts of value not less than Rs. 18.00 Crore each for similar work.

**Similar services refer to Field Operation of BTG & BOP/WTP/Ash Handling Plant of Thermal Power Plant excluding main plant control room operation.

- 3) Minimum Average Annual Turnover** of the Bidder from Similar service in Power plant having Unit Size greater than 300 MW shall not be less than Rs 40.00 Crore in last 3(Three) Years of executed work.

- 4) Audited Balance Sheet and profit & Loss A/C must be submitted along with the Techno-commercial Bid. In case the account is not audited a certificate from a chartered accountant should be produced towards turnover.

- 5) Safety requirement-Bidder loss time hours must have been less than 200Hrs in last 3 years. (Contractor's self-certification)

- 6) Must not have been disqualified/blacklisted in any public/Govt sector / IPP/ CPP.
- 7) The bidder must have own Provident Fund Registration certificate, ESI Registration certificate, Income Tax PAN and GST certificate. Photocopies of these documents must be submitted along with Techno-commercial Bid.

Documents to be submitted in support of QR

- 1) Relevant PO copy and Client's completion certificate, certificate for ongoing works will be considered also.
- 2) For all qualification criteria all supporting documents to be provided.
- 3) Audited balance sheet including Profit & Loss statement for the previous three completed financial years reckoned from the date of application. In case the documents are not ready/ available, then certified copy by a registered practicing Chartered accountant may be submitted.
- 4) Any other documents in addition to the above which the applicant wants to submit.

Note:

- Owner reserves the right to obtain necessary documents and also to assess the qualification of the Bidder, subsequent to submission of bid, as deemed necessary by Owner to establish bidder's qualification.
- Sufficient documentary proof in support of the above must be submitted along with the Techno-Commercial Bid. Photocopies of supporting documents must be submitted along with Techno-Commercial Bid.
- Tenders submitted without the above techno-commercial requirements shall be liable for rejection.
- The bidders who are found qualified in the above will be invited for the opening of the price bids.
